Acting Chairman Westbrook announced a recess of the MVSF's meeting at 10:45 a.m. in order to conduct hearings related to the Motor Vehicle law.

The MVSF's meeting reconvened at 2:58 p.m.

Acting Chairman Westbrook called to order Hearing #2020-012, LaRocca's Auto Sales, Inc. for alleged violation of engaging in the business of making consumer loans and/or origination of consumer credit sales without a license issued by the Commission. Representing LaRocca's Auto Sales, Inc. was: Robert Harvey, Sr. Esq. and Joseph R. LaRocca, Owner. A court reporter was brought in to record the transcript of the hearing, which will be made a permanent part of the Commission's files. The following Judgment was rendered.

JUDGMENT:

On Monday, March 8,2021, a hearing on the merits of this cause was had before the Commissioners of the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission (the "Commission") and on May 17, 2021 a determination of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Ruling was made by the Commission in an open meeting.

And after hearing the testimony adduced at trial, the receipt of the documentary evidence into the record, and for reasons orally assigned, the Commission makes the following finding of facts and conclusions of law:

FINDING OF FACTS:

- 1. LaRocca's Auto Sales, Inc. is a used motor vehicle dealer;
- 2. LaRocca's Auto Sales, Inc. publicly advertised to make consumer loans to purchase motor vehicles using Internet advertising;
- 3. LaRocca's Auto Sales, Inc. did not possess a Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission Sales Finance license at the time it engaged in public advertising to make consumer loans.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

 LaRocca's Auto Sales, Inc. engaged in the business of making consumer loans without the required license in violation of Louisiana Administrative Code Title 6. Part VII. Chapter 10-B Louisiana Motor Vehicle Sales Finance Act §969.35.

Considering the forgoing findings of fact and conclusion of law, and pursuant to the authority vested in the Commission as set forth in La. R.S. 32:1251, et seq.:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Auto Sales, Inc. be and is hereby assessed a fine in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Auto Sales, Inc. also assessed court costs in the full board hearing of this matter in the amount of FOUR THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND FORTY-SIX DOLLARS AND FIFTY-TWO CENTS (\$4,746.52), to be paid to the Commission.

Licensing §7301.A.(1) (a) &(b) License Requirement and Exception. In attendance representing E. B. Wilkes Group L.L.C. The Executive Director advised the Commission Members the following Consent Judgment had been recommended by Chairman Krake and accepted by the representative of E. B. Wilkes Group L.L.C. DBA Wilkes Motors, if accepted and ratified by the Commission. Commissioner Lane made a motion to accept and ratify the Consent Judgment in this matter. Commissioner Scoggin seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

CONSENT JUDGMENT

After considering the entire record in this matter and the interest of the parties in amicably resolving it, the parties have consented to a judgment in favor of the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission based upon alleged violations by E. B. Wilkes Group L.L.C. DBA Wilkes Motors of Louisiana Administrative Code Title 6. Part VII. Chapter 10-B Louisiana Motor Vehicle Sales Finance Act §969.35.A.(1) and Louisiana Administrative Code Title 46. Part V. Subpart 3. Chapter 73. Licensing §7301.A.(1) (a) &(b) License Requirement and Exception. Therefore, based on the parties' mutual consent:

IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between E. B. Wilkes Group L.L.C. DBA Wilkes Motors and the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission that respondent waives:

- A. Any further procedural rights or remedies afforded under the law;
- B. The requirement that the Commission's judgment recites statement of a findings of fact and conclusions of law; and
- C. All rights to seek judicial review or otherwise to challenge or contest the validity of the judgment entered pursuant to this agreement.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER AGREED the Notice of Hearing may be used in construing the terms of the order. No agreement, understanding, representation or interpretation not contained in the order or the agreement may be used to vary or contradict the terms of the order.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that E. B. Wilkes Group L.L.C. DBA Wilkes Motors in complete satisfaction of all above-referenced violations, pay a fine to the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission in the amount of TWENTY-FIVE HUNDRED (\$2,500.00) DOLLARS. The Commission agrees, as part of this settlement, that the consent judgment is prospective so any other alleged violation by E. B. Wilkes Group L.L.C. DBA Wilkes Motors of the same provision that pre-dates this consent judgment will not be pursued as a violation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that TWENTY-FIVE HUNDRED (\$2,500.00) DOLLARS of this fine be suspended conditioned upon E. B. Wilkes Group L.L.C. DBA Wilkes Motors being placed on ONE (1) YEAR probation beginning the date this Consent Judgment is rendered and signed and adhering to all Rules and Regulations of this Commission and Louisiana laws applicable to this Commission during the probationary period. In the event of a violation during the probationary period, the suspended portion of the fine shall become due and payable in full. The type of violation referenced herein does not include any dealer related disputes.
