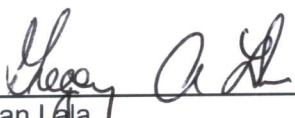

Commissioner Courville made a motion to authorize Chairman Lala to execute, modify as needed, and sign the settlement agreement. Commissioner Lane seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.
