

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE
LOUISIANA MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION
3017 Kingman Street
Metairie, Louisiana 70006
Monday, March 30, 2026
At 10:00 a.m.**

The meeting was called to order at 9:59 a.m. by Chairman Greg A. Lala.

Chairman Lala called for the Commission to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Lala stated that Gregory Reggie would like to address the Commission. Mr. Reggie announced his decision not to renew his contract with the Commission. He further provided his farewell remarks and reflected on his forty-year relationship with the Commission. Chairman Lala, Commissioner LeBlanc, and Counselor LaPeyronnie spoke on their appreciation for Counselor Reggie's service to the Commission.

Executive Director Casey reported on the legislation for the 2026 legislative session. Executive Director Casey first advised on SB 102 which is being proposed by Louisiana Automobile Dealers Association ("LADA.") The bill relates to an association having a *Private Right to Action*, which would allow an association to file a complaint on behalf of a member or members against a motor vehicle manufacturer with the Commission or in a court of competent jurisdiction and adding an amendment fee to update the license to reflect operational changes such as dealer-operator, ownership, name, location, and vehicles authorized to sell. She advised that she had conversations and meetings with LADA President Coulter McMahan regarding potential conflicts the bill has with current Commission statutes. Commissioner Hebert asks what is the reasoning for the bill. Executive Director Casey advised that the bill is partially related to the fact that dealers are currently unable to recoup legal fees and damages when filing a complaint with the Commission. She stated that Commission statutes do not allow motor vehicle dealers to recoup legal fees; however, Commission statutes do allow for marine dealers to recoup legal fees in certain situations. She further explained that another reason is so that a dealer or group of dealers can file a complaint anonymously through an association. Chairman Lala recognized the importance of the Commission to maintain a relationship with industry associations, such as LADA.

Next, Executive Director Casey advised on HB 848 noting that this bill defines service requirements and service facilities for all-terrain vehicle dealers and adds golf carts to the definition of all-terrain vehicle.

Executive Director Casey then discussed HB 939 which is related to the merger of the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission and the Louisiana Used Motor Vehicle Commission. She stated that at this point it is a shell bill and that the Commission is working with the author to assist in the writing of the details of the statute.

Executive Director Casey advised on HB 781. This is an Office of Motor Vehicles bill that would allow businesses that own fleet vehicles to license and register their own vehicles.

Next, Executive Director Casey advised on HB 885 which would allow motor vehicle dealers to register and title their own vehicles.

Executive Director Casey discussed HB 888 which would provide for more regulation of temporary dealer plates to prevent misuse.

At this time, Executive Director Casey began a discussion on the possibility of a rule or law being created that would require a dealer to have a customer sign a disclosure acknowledging the purchase of any dealer added options or services that have been added to the advertised sale price of a vehicle at the time of the sale. She asked Investigator Supervisor Scott Landreneau to explain the need for the disclosure. He advised that the Commission is trying to address the issue where a dealer is adding the cost of dealer added options to the advertised sale price of vehicle when a potential buyer comes into the dealership. The buyer may not be aware of the added cost or is told that the added cost is a requirement. Investigator Supervisor Landreneau discussed the complaints the Commission has been receiving regarding this issue and the challenges regulating advertising and proper disclosures to the consumers. He stated that when an investigator looks at a deal for a past sale, they may not know if the customer is aware that the dealer has added products or services to the advertised price. After a brief discussion, Commissioner Corley made a motion to allow Commission staff to create a disclosure form and for said disclosure to be reviewed by the Commissioners at the next Commission meeting on May 18th. Commissioner Guidry seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.

At this time, Executive Director Casey asked the Commission to approve an amended contract for Counselor LaPeyronnie to extend the duration of the contract and increase the salary. The salary was amended to a maximum of \$300,000.00 and the term was extended to January 11, 2027. Commissioner Courville made a motion to approve Counselor LaPeyronnie's amended contract. Commissioner Hargroder seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.

Next, Executive Director Casey announced that the 2025 Fiscal Year Audit is finalized. The Legislative Auditor replied to the Commission's question regarding a possible error in the stated amount of a certain Commission liability. The Legislative Auditor agreed that an error was made. Executive Director Casey asked the Commissioners to review documents pertaining to the Fiscal Year 2025 Audit, the 2024-2025 Actuals, and the 2026 Fiscal Year to date vs Budget. At this time, Executive Director Casey asked Accountant Flannery to go over some of the highlights of the audit. Accountant Flannery advised that there was an increase in net position, increase in operating revenue, and a decrease in non-operating revenues. She further advised that there was no schedule of findings or management's corrective actions.

Executive Director Casey asked the Commission to vote on the Commission's 2027 fiscal year participation on the Occupational Licensing Review Program. Commissioner Waddell made a motion to participate in the Occupational Licensing Review Program. Commissioner Hargroder seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.

Executive Director Casey presented to the members of the Commission the operating statistics for the months of January and February, which included a comparison of last year's statistics for the same time frame. She explained that the drastic increase in consumer complaints received was due to the new Commission website which allows complaints to be received digitally.

At this time, Executive Director Casey asked Investigator Supervisor Landreneau to inform the Commission on trends that the investigation team was seeing. He stated that the Commission was seeing more dealer-on-dealer complaints, RAM and Jeep dealers are frustrated with Stellantis due to a stop-sell on certain RAM and Jeeps models. Investigator Supervisor Landreneau advised that dealers are struggling to sell new products, especially recreational product dealers. He also stated that golf cart and LSV dealers are having difficulties with titling and registering these vehicles.

Next, Executive Director Casey reported that the Commission's Welcome Home Act and ADA Attendance Rules have been published.




