Executive Director Casey advised the Commission Members a pre-hearing had been held on March 30, 2026, pursuant to LA-R.S. 49:977.3(C), regarding Matter #P-2026-063, Easy Car Finance, LLC DBA Easy Car Finance, 3536 N. Causeway Blvd., Metairie, LA 70002, for alleged violations of LA-R.S. 6:969.35.A. (1); Louisiana Administrative Code Title 46. Part V. Subpart 3. Chapter 73. Licensing §7301. License Requirement and Exception A.(1) a. & b. and J. In attendance representing Easy Car Finance, LLC was Azzam Massassati, Owner; and representing the Commission were: Chairman Gregory LaLa; Counselor Adrian LaPeyronnie; Scott Landreneau, Commission Investigator Supervisor; Neil Rogers and Antoine DeRouen, Commission Investigators; Brandy DeLucca and Antoinette Moore, License Analysts; and Amy Casey, Executive Director. The Executive Director advised the Commission Members the following Consent Judgment had been recommended by Chairman Gregory LaLa and accepted by the representative of Easy Car Finance, LLC, if accepted and ratified by the Commission. Commissioner Vaughn made a motion to accept and ratify the Consent Judgment in this matter. Commissioner Hocevar seconded this motion, and it was unanimously approved.

CONSENT JUDGMENT

After considering the entire record in this matter and the interest of the parties in amicably resolving it, the parties have consented to a judgment in favor of the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission based upon alleged violations by Easy Car Finance, LLC DBA Easy Car Finance of LA-R.S. 6:969.35.A. (1); Louisiana Administrative Code Title 46. Part V. Subpart 3. Chapter 73. Licensing §7301. License Requirement and Exception A.(1) a. & b. and J.. Therefore, based on the parties' mutual consent:

IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between Easy Car Finance, LLC DBA Easy Car Finance and the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission that respondent waives:

- A. Any further procedural rights or remedies afforded under the law;
- B. The requirement that the Commission's judgment recites statement of a findings of fact and conclusions of law; and

C. All rights to seek judicial review or otherwise to challenge or contest the validity of the judgment entered pursuant to this agreement.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER AGREED that the Notice issued in the above-captioned matter may be used in construing the terms of the order. No agreement, understanding, representation or interpretation not contained in the order or the agreement may be used to vary or contradict the terms of the order.

IT IS AGREED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Easy Car Finance, LLC DBA Easy Car Finance, in complete satisfaction of all above-referenced violations, pay a fine to the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission in the amount of FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS. The Commission agrees, as part of this settlement, that the consent judgment is prospective so any other alleged violation by Easy Car Finance, LLC DBA Easy Car Finance of the same provision that pre-dates the violation(s) addressed in this consent judgment will not be pursued as a violation.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that FOUR THOUSAND (\$4,000.00) DOLLARS of this fine be suspended conditioned upon Easy Car Finance, LLC DBA Easy Car Finance being placed on TWENTY-FOUR (24) MONTH probation beginning the date this consent judgment is rendered and signed and adhering to all Rules and Regulations of this Commission and Louisiana laws applicable to this Commission during the probationary period. In the event of a violation during the probationary period, the suspended portion of the fine shall become due and payable in full. The type of violation referenced herein does not include any dealer-related disputes.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Easy Car Finance, LLC DBA Easy Car Finance pay the administrative cost to the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission in the amount of FOUR HUNDRED (\$400.00) DOLLARS.

Chairman Lala called for a review of the GAP Administrator licenses issued.

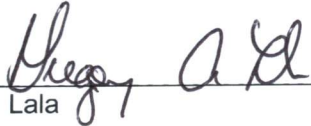

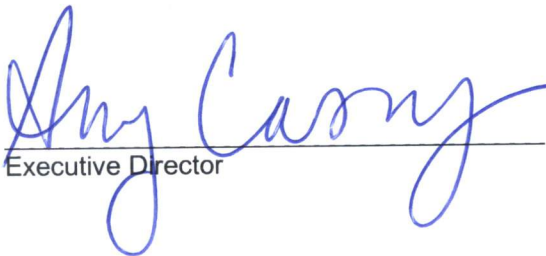
