RE: Convenience Fee – Act No. 925

La. R.S. 6:969.18 A. (3) provides:

The seller or extender of credit may additionally charge the consumer a convenience fee, as provided by R.S. 47:532.1(A)(7)(c), for services performed in obtaining a motor vehicle license or title on the consumer's behalf.

Act No. 925 of Louisiana 2026 Regular Legislative Session amended La. R.S. 47:532.1 C (change in red.) to read as follows:

La. R.S. 47:532.1 C.: Public license tag agents shall be authorized to collect a convenience charge in addition to the registration license tax or other authorized fees, sales taxes, and transactions. The convenience charge shall not exceed ~~twenty-three~~ **twenty-seven** dollars per authorized transaction. However, the public license tag agents shall collect and retain the full amount of the convenience charge. The seller is authorized to collect the convenience charge authorized by this Subsection in connection with any retail sale, in addition to the fees authorized in Chapter 10-B of Title 6 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.

WHAT THIS MEANS:

La. R.S. 6:969.18 (A) was amended to increase the maximum convenience fee amount to be collected by a vehicle seller or extender of credit from \$23.00 to \$27.00 per authorized transaction. This convenience fee (max \$27.00) may be collected when a Public Tag Agent is used in obtaining a license plate, registration, or title on the consumer's behalf or for any other transaction authorized by law. This change went into effect on August 1, 2026. Please note no portion of the convenience fee may be retained by the seller (dealer) or extender of credit. The fee collected must be paid to the Public Tag Agent for the services performed.
